**TOPIC:** JESUS FORGIVES AND HEALS

**INTRODUCTION:**

Jesus “preached the Word.” This was not entertainment, or “show business,” or a “healing campaign.” He simply “preached the Word” to those who were hungry to hear. People recognized that this was not just another man. He spoke with all the authority of God. A paralyzed man and his four friends recognized that here was the answer to a desperate need. Their faith gave them persistence against all obstacles. The crowd came between them and the Lord. But they found another way—through the roof. The faith that moves mountains is not limited to convention. It is a faith of action, and a faith of persistence. Above all it is a faith in God.

Jesus saw their hearts. He saw their faith. He also saw a need, and He had compassion. No stage, no admission cards to a “healing line.” The man came to Jesus, and went away forgiven and healed.

The crowd was a hindrance to his coming. But his four friends brought him to Jesus. Jesus did the rest!

By God’s grace, may we imitate the four friends—and not the crowd!

**CENTRAL TRUTH:** If we expect Jesus to meet our physical needs, we must first permit Him to cure our spiritual life.

**GOLDEN TEXT:** . . . *THY SINS BE FORGIVEN THEE.*

Mark 2:5b

Tremendous progress has been made in modern-day medicine and public health. But man’s greatest need, his spiritual health, is often so sadly neglected. Christ still has compassion. “... *him that cometh unto me, I will in no wise cast out.*” (John 6:37) He is still the one and only remedy for a sin-sick soul. “*Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.*” (Acts 4:12)

Christ is the timeless, ageless remedy for both the sinful nature, and for sins. In Christ we receive both forgiveness of sins that have been committed—and a new nature, “... *old things ... passed away ... all things ... become new.*” (2 Corinthians 5:17)
