**TOPIC:** SERVICE

**INTRODUCTION:**

Very often people think of works being meant by the word “service.” They become involved in doing good deeds in committees, organizations, meetings, etc., in which they believe they are serving God. So much is involved that no room is left for the Holy Spirit’s guidance. He is completely left out. Such works are only wood, hay and stubble and will be burned.

The true service to God is to be so yielded that the Holy Spirit has complete control. When He says do this or that, we do it. We must be ready to do His bidding at a moment’s notice not by planned arrangements by man. His works are works of love, faith, humility, gentleness, goodness, longsuffering, peace, etc. They are works of gold, silver, and precious stones that the fire cannot consume. For these we shall receive rewards.

**CENTRAL TRUTH:** The rewards of our Christian service will be based on its quality even more than its quantity.

***GOLDEN TEXT: IF ANY MAN SERVE ME, HIM WILL MY FATHER HONOR.***

John 12:26

When Jesus was on this earth, He set us an example of service. He not only served the Father, doing the works to which he had been appointed, but He also served mankind. Because of this faithful service, God honored Him with His help and presence, with the answers to His prayers, even sending angels to comfort and sustain Him.

As Jesus’ mission was to make man one with God, as He is one with God, this great blessing is now extended to all who serve Him in promoting this union with one another and with God.

What a precious promise we have when we enter into Christ’s service. “As Thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world.” (John 17:18) “And the glory which Thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one.” (John 17:22)
